16 **A RESOLUTION** concerning

18 **City Supported Special Events in Fiscal Year 2023**

20 **FOR** the purpose of identifying City Supported Special Events; and waiving certain
21 related City Fees during Fiscal Year 2023.

24 **WHEREAS,** Section 14.18.020 of the City Code defines a “City Supported Event” as “a
25 special event that:

- 26 1. the city council approves by resolution as a city-supported event;
27 2. inures solely to the benefit of the public, with no profit or emolument
28 to the City to thereby serve a governmental function; and
29 3. benefits the public health, safety and welfare to thereby serve a
30 governmental purpose”; and

32 **WHEREAS,** Section 6.04.210 of the City Code states that “whenever a person leases,
33 uses or occupies a City facility, the person shall be charged and pay a
34 minimum of full fees for the use of the facility.” Examples of City facilities
35 include public spaces, grounds, parks, athletic facilities, fields, docks, piers,
36 wet slips, moorings, developable waters, buildings, motor vehicles,
37 equipment, structures, rooms or other parts of public buildings. Examples
38 of City services include traffic control, crowd control, public safety support
39 (police or fire), trash removal, sanitary services, recycling, bulk pick-up, the
40 provision of water, sewer, electricity, communications or other utilities,
41 transportation, and labor. Full fees “means the value of the right to lease,
42 use or occupy the City facility as determined by the Finance Director in a
43 fiscal impact note, plus all costs incurred by the City of Annapolis
44 including, but not limited to, utility costs and costs associated with

1 municipal services (public safety, public works, custodial, renovations,
2 repairs, maintenance, transportation, and parking)”; and

4 **WHEREAS,** Section 6.04.210 of the City Code further states that the fees for City
5 Services may be waived “by resolution of the City Council pursuant to
6 guidelines approved by the City Council.”

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9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL**
10 that the following Special Events are designated City Supported Special Events during
11 Fiscal Year 2023, in recognition of their significance to our heritage and public service to
12 our City:
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- 14 • Independence Day Parade
- 15 • Elk’s Pre-Labor Day Parade
- 16 • Kunta Kinte Festival
- 17 • Tug of War
- 18 • Veterans Day Ceremony
- 19 • Grand Illumination
- 20 • Lights Parade
- 21 • New Year’s Eve Celebration
- 22 • St. Patrick’s Day Parade
- 23 • Martin Luther King, Jr. Parade and Diaspora Concert and Festival
- 24 • Memorial Day Parade
- 25 • Juneteenth Parade and Festival

27 **AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that
28 there shall be a waiver of certain fees for the designated City Supported Special Events that
29 are identified in the Staff Report attached to this Resolution and incorporated by reference.

31 **AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that
32 this resolution shall take effect from the date of its passage.
