28	SECT	TION I: BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that the Charter
29	of the	City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as follows:

32	Artic	e II - ELECTION OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN/ALDERWOMEN

34	Sec. 6	- Board of supervisors of elections.

36	<u>A.</u>	There is a board of supervisors of elections of the City of Annapolis, consisting of three
37		(3) residents in and voters of the city, two (2) of whom shall always be selected from the
38		leading political parties of the state, one (1) from each of such parties. The third member
39		may be selected from either of the leading political parties of the state or from any other
40		political party. The Board of Supervisors of Elections shall be comprised of five residents
41		who are also registered voters of the city: two of whom are from the leading political
42		parties of the state, two of whom are from either of the leading political parties of the
43		state, and one of whom is not a member of either of the leading political parties of the
44		state. The members shall be persons of approved integrity and capacity, and may not hold
45		elective office, nor be candidates for elective office during their terms of office. Members
46		shall serve without compensation.

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SECTION II: AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY
COUNCIL that a notice of public hearing was published on the proposed charter amendment, at
least 21 days in advance of the public hearing that was held on.

SECTION III: AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY
COUNCIL that the date of adoption of this Resolution is \_\_\_\_\_\_, 2022, and the amendments of the

  the space provided on the effective date of the change.
- SECTION V: AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that as soon as the Charter Amendment hereby enacted shall become effective, either as provided herein or following a referendum, the Mayor shall send to the Maryland Department of Legislative Services a copy of this Resolution showing the number of Aldermen and Alderwomen voting for and against it and a report on the votes cast for or against the amendment hereby enacted at any referendum thereon and the date of such referendum.
