> **Explanation**: This supplemental allocation appropriates an additional \$575.00 to the 2022 Emergency Management Performance Grant. The grant amount included in the FY2023 Adopted Budget was \$85,000. The EMPG program provides resources to local government all-hazards emergency management agencies, an approach to emergency response, including the development of a comprehensive program of grant planning, training, and exercises, as well as staffing/EOC upgrades. This program requires a 100% local match which is obtained through the Office of Emergency Management personnel salary.
