Seconded. CARRIED voice vote

Amendment #2:

On page 2, line 7, strike "and then lie on the table after which shall be read the second time and final action taken"

2. ANY ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION WAIVING OR REDUCING CITY FEES SHALL BE REFERRED TO THE FINANCE COMMITTEE (Strike - AND THEN LIE ON THE TABLE AFTER WHICH SHALL BE READ THE SECOND TIME AND FINAL ACTION TAKEN - End of Strike out). Seconded. CARRIED on voice vote.

Alderman Arnett moved to Recommend Favorably O-41-22 with Amendments. Seconded. CARRIED on voice vote.
