Ordinance: O-19-23

**Title:** Property tax credits for 9-1-1 Specialists and PSO's

**Date:** May 18, 2023

This ordinance provides property tax credits allowed by Maryland state law for the City of Annapolis 9-1-1 specialists and public safety officers in the Annapolis Fire Department and Police Department. The credit may not exceed the lesser of \$2,500 per dwelling or the amount of property tax imposed on the dwelling. Based on the current employee data and property information from the 2023 tax rolls, there are eight employees who qualify for the credit and the City would lose approximately \$16,800 of annual tax revenue.
