Planning and Zoning - Parking and Loading Regulations -Parking fee-in-lieu of meeting off-street parking requirements.

AMENDMENT 1 – ALD. SAVIDGE

AMENDMENT SUMMARY:

- 1) Creates a new fund in the budget to pay for infrastructure and transit that improves pedestrian mobility in the city.
- 2) Requires the parking fee in lieu of meeting off-street parking requirements to be placed in the new fund.

PART 1 | Creation of New Chapter and Fund

Title 6 - REVENUE AND FINANCE Chapter 6.30 - SPECIAL FUNDS Section 6.30.010 - MOBILITY AND PARKING ENHANCEMENT SPECIAL REVENUE FUND

- A. **PURPOSE.** THERE IS A "MOBILITY AND PARKING ENHANCEMENT SPECIAL REVENUE FUND" FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING CAPITAL EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH EXPANDING AND MAKING SAFER, NON-AUTOMOBILE AND NON-TRANSIT-ORIENTED TRANSPORTATION AND MOBILITY AND EXPANDING PARKING FACILITIES. THE FUND SHALL ENCOURAGE ALTERNATIVE MOBILITY OPTIONS IN THE CITY, INCLUDING CYCLING, WALKING AND PUBLIC TRANSIT MODES.
- B. FUND USE.
 - 1. FUNDS SHALL BE USED FOR ACTIVITIES RELATING TO SAFE AND EXPANDED NON-AUTOMOBILE MOBILITY AND EXPANDED GENERAL PARKING IN THE CITY, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:
 - A. PROJECTS FOR VARIOUS MODES OF TRANSPORTATION, AND
 - B. THE PLANNING, DESIGN, ENGINEERING, CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS RELATING TO PARKING AND NON-AUTOMOBILE MOBILITY IN THE CITY.

- C. ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS, PEDESTRIAN, BICYCLE, AND MULTI-USE TRAILS, PARKING FACILITIES, STAFFING AND ADMINISTRATION, AND
- D. ALL OTHER COSTS RELATED TO PARKING AND NON-AUTOMOBILE MOBILITY ACTIVITIES IN THE CITY.
- 2. THE FUNDS SHALL BE PRIORITIZED FOR USE IN COMMUNITIES:
 - A. THAT NEED IMPROVED MOBILITY; OR
 - B. REQUIRE PARKING IMPROVEMENTS TO ADDRESS EXISTING DEFICIENCIES; OR
 - C. TO ADDRESS CIRCUMSTANCES WHERE BUSINESS OWNERS HAVE UTILIZED THE PARKING FEE-IN-LIEU PROGRAM IN TITLE 21 § 66.035
- C. **REVENUE SOURCE.** THE ANNUAL PARKING FEE-IN-LIEU OF PROVIDING PARKING UNDER TITLE 21 § 66.035 SHALL BE DEPOSITED BY THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE INTO THIS SEPARATE SPECIAL REVENUE FUND THAT MAY ONLY BE USED FOR THE PURPOSES OUTLINED IN SUBSECTION B ABOVE.

D. IMPLEMENTATION.

- 1. MOBILITY AND PARKING ENHANCEMENT FUND FUNDS ESTABLISHED IN THIS SECTION ARE DISTINGUISHABLE FROM THE TRANSPORTATION FUND ESTABLISHED IN TITLE 6 § 16.010 FOR MAINTAINING TRANSPORTATION NEEDS.
- 2. THE CITY MANAGER OR THEIR DESIGNEE SHALL PROMULGATE PROCEDURES FOR THE ACCOUNTING AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE FUND AND REPORT THE INFORMATION TO THE FINANCE COMMITTEE DURING ANNUAL BUDGET DELIBERATIONS.

PART 2 | Requiring In-Lieu Fee to Go Into New Fund:

In O-49-22, on page 2 in line 10, strike "Transportation" and insert "Mobility and Parking Enhancement Special Revenue Fund ".

CHANGES TO BILL:

C. All fees generated as a result of requests for waiving the off-street parking requirement shall be deposited into the city Transportation Mobility and Parking Enhancement Special Revenue Fund.
