Requiring the City Manager to Provide Staffing Impact Statements on Pending Legislation

AMENDMENT 3 – ALD. ARNETT

Amendment Summary

This amendment to O-17-23 adds the requirement that if Fiscal Impact Notes and Staffing Impact Reports are not ready by First Reader, the legislation must wait until the next City Council agenda.

On page 3, in line 17, insert paragraph 3, "If the fiscal impact note or staffing impact report are not ready upon First Reader, the legislation shall be held until the next City Council meeting agenda."

Subsection 2.16.090(E)

- E. <u>1. Fiscal Impact Note.</u> The Finance Director shall submit a fiscal impact note on every ordinance, charter amendment, and resolution no later than the date of the <u>legislation's introduction on First Reader.</u>
 - 2. **Staffing Impact Report.** The City Manager shall submit a staffing impact report on every ordinance, charter amendment, and resolution no later than the date of the legislation's introduction on First Reader.
 - 3. If the fiscal impact note or staffing impact report are not ready by the date the legislation is set for First Reader, the legislation shall be held until the next City Council meeting agenda.
