Subject: R-4-24: The 2024 City of Annapolis Comprehensive Plan

Purpose of legislation

The purpose of this legislation is to adopt a new comprehensive plan to provide guidance on future land use for the City of Annapolis.

Impact of legislation on operations

The City is pleased to submit the Comprehensive Plan to Council after a lengthy process that brought together citizen input, city council feedback, data analysis, and best practices from the planning profession and other jurisdictions. The City is required by the State of Maryland to adopt a Comprehensive Plan every ten years. Failure to do so can result in the loss of state aid. This legislation will enable normal operations to continue.

Impact of legislation on staffing

This legislation does not impact staffing.
