Fines for Violating Annapolis Noise Restrictions

AMENDMENT 1 – ALD. TIERNEY

Finance Committee chair filing on behalf of the committee

Amendment Summary:

O-28-23, as written, contained a new fine dealing with noise restrictions in § 11.12.020. However, the fine section for the Chapter overall is § 11.12.120.

This amendment: 1) incorporates the noise fine into the Chapter's fine section, § 11.12.120, and 2) removes "per day" from that fine section, and 3) fixes a typo.

On page 1, strike line 31 in its entirety and insert the following:
