O-4-24

Residency Requirement for Liquor Licenses

This summary was prepared by the City of Annapolis Office of Law for use by members of the Annapolis City Council during consideration of the legislation.

BILL SUMMARY

O-4-24 eliminates the requirement that anyone applying for a City of Annapolis liquor license must be a resident, taxpayer and a registered vote of the City or Anne Arundel County.

BACKGROUND

The change is prompted by a change in state law and an interpretation of the Maryland Attorney General from 2019.
