Re: Parking District Amendment

Parking District #2; Shipwright Street

Dear Mr. Mayor and Members of Council:

On July 23, 2014, the Annapolis Transportation Board met and passed the following:

THE TRANSPORTATION BOARD HEREBY RECOMMENDS TO THE CITY COUNCIL THAT PARKING DISTRICT #2 FOR THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS BE AMENDED SO THAT THE SOUTHEAST END OF SHIPWRIGHT STREET, THAT IS, FROM A POINT BETWEEN 5 SHIPWRIGHT STREET AND 7 SHIPWRIGHT STREET TO THE WATER TERMINUS OF THE STREET, BE REMOVED FROM PARKING DISTRICT #2, IN ORDER TO PRESERVE THE TRADITIONAL PARKING AVAILABILITY ON THAT STREET TO BOATERS AND OTHERS WHO USE THE NEARBY MARINA.

Pursuant to the City Code, all amendments to the Parking Districts in the City of Annapolis must first be passed by the Transportation Board before being considered by Council. It is our understanding that the City Council will soon take up this amendment to Parking District #2 at a future meeting.

Further, in order to help resolve the newly discovered "glitch" in the parking district scheme, the Board is requesting, by separate letter, an abatement of the parking enforcement at the above-referenced end of Shipwright Street, and additionally requesting the issuance of 30 "hang tags" to the owners of the 15 marina slips at Olde Town Marina so that marina business can proceed in the traditional sense, during this busy season, until the Council has acted on the proposed changes.
