Parking Motor Homes

FOR the purpose of regulating the parking of Motor Homes on City streets; and matters generally relating to parking Motor Homes.

To date the Annapolis Police and Parking Enforcement have prosecuted the parking of motor homes on City streets in residential areas as though they were trucks. The Transportation Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland defines motor homes as other than trucks or buses.

The Annapolis City Council wishes to regulate the size of vehicles parked in residential areas to allow for the safe passage of vehicles along narrow and crowded streets. Section 12.20.100 of the Code of the City of Annapolis allows parking of trucks up to certain dimensions on streets in residential areas. Section 12.20.110 of the Code of the City of Annapolis allows temporary parking of camping trailers on City streets.

This legislation will authorize the City to regulate the parking of motor homes on City Streets.
