4	SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS
5	CITY COUNCIL that the Code of the City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as
6	follows:

8	CHAPTER 12.20 - STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING
9	
10	12.20.170 - Fifteen-minute parking limit on portions of Northwest Street.
11	
12	A. It is unlawful and a misdemeanor for the driver of any vehicle to park such vehicle
13	for longer than fifteen minutes on Northwest Street on the post office side where
14	signs have been erected designating spaces for fifteen minute parking.
15	
16	B. Any person violating this section, upon conviction, is subject to a fine as established
17	by resolution of the City Council.
18	
19	SECTION II: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE
20	ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that this Ordinance shall take effect from the date of its
21	passage.
