22	FOR the purpose of changing the deadlines for designating and appointing members to
23	the Board of Supervisors of Elections.

25	<b>BY</b> amending the following portions of the Annapolis City Charter:
26	Article II, Section 6.
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29	SECTION I: BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL
30	that the Charter of the City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as follows:
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32	ARTICLE II – Election of Mayor and Aldermen
33	Sec. 6 – Board of supervisors of elections.
34 25	(a) There is a board of supervisors of elections of the City of Annapolis,
35 36	(a) There is a board of supervisors of elections of the City of Annapolis, consisting of three (3) residents in and voters of the city, two (2) of whom shall always be
37	selected from the leading political parties of the state, one (1) from each of such parties.
38	The third member may be selected from either of the leading political parties of the state
39	or from any other political party. The members shall be persons of approved integrity and
40	capacity, and may not hold elective office, nor be candidates for elective office during
41	their terms of office. Members shall serve without compensation.

43	(bc) Members of the Board of Supervisors of Elections shall be appointed by
44	the City Council for a term that begins on the second Monday of March following the
45	General City Election in the preceding November and ends four (4) years later on the
46	second Monday in March. In the event of a vacancy, the City Council shall immediately

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fill the vacancy only for the remainder of the four-year term. A member must be 1 reappointed for a new term in order to serve beyond any four-year term. A chair of the 2 Board of Supervisors of Elections shall be chosen annually by its members. 3 4 Before appointing any supervisors of election, the city council shall 5 request the city central committees representing the two (2) leading political parties of the 6 state in the city each to designate at least four (4) eligible candidates for the position to be 7 filled, by the second Monday in March FEBRUARY. If a city central committee fails to 8 nominate the required number of candidates as provided herein, the mayor shall submit a 9 10 list of nominees to the city council in addition to the central committee's list by the first Monday in April MARCH.
