1 CITY OF ANNAPOLIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 2 TO LEASE AGREEMENT 3 THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO LEASE AGREEMENT is made this _____ day of 4 _, 2015 (the "Amendment"), by and between the City of Annapolis, a municipal 5 corporation of the State of Maryland ("Lessor"), and ANNAPOLIS MARITIME MUSEUM, 6 **INC.**, a Maryland corporation, its successors and assigns (collectively, the "Lessee"). 7 WHEREAS, by Lease Agreement dated February 15, 2006 ("Lease"), the Lessor leased 8 the property consisting of the "McNasby" building located at 723 Second Street, the Bargehouse 9 located at 133 Bayshore Drive, and all open space common areas and docking facilities, as further described in the Lease (the "Premises") to the Lessee; and 10 11 WHEREAS, both parties now desire to amend the Lease to adjust the rent and other 12 material terms. 13 NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto mutually agree for good and valuable 14 consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged and agreed as follows: 15 1. The first "WHEREAS" paragraph of the Lease shall be deleted and the following shall be 16 inserted in lieu thereof: 17 WHEREAS, Lessor owns the property known as the McNasby's/Bargehouse site located 18 at 723 Second Street in Annapolis, Maryland, as more accurately described in a Deed 19 recorded at Liber 04939, folio 503 among the Land Records of Anne Arundel County, 20 and all improvements located thereon; and 21 2. Paragraph 3 of the Lease shall be deleted and the following shall be inserted in lieu 22 thereof: 23 Waiver of Rent: In lieu of monetary rental payments, and recognizing the Lessee's prior 24 substantial expenditures for and improvements to the Premises, the Lessee, at its sole 25 cost and expense, shall continue to provide maintenance and repair services for the 26 Premises as specified in the Lease and this Amendment, to complete various projects for 27 the Premises, including those set forth in a Master Agreement dated January 21, 2015 28 attached as Exhibit A (collectively the "Projects"), and to otherwise perform all interior 29 and exterior maintenance, repairs and services to and for the Premises. 30 31 3. Paragraph 8 of the Lease shall be deleted and the following shall be inserted in lieu 32 thereof: 33 Maintenance of the Premises: The Lessee shall be solely responsible for the maintenance 34 of the Premises and shall keep in good repair all improvements located therein. Such 35 maintenance shall include, but shall not be limited to, all janitorial work, HVAC, 36 plumbing, electric and related items. In addition, the Lessee assumes responsibility for 37 maintenance of the Premises, and shall police, light and maintain the Premises in a 38 clean, safe and secure manner. The Lessee shall be responsible for the maintenance and 39 operation of all building systems for the Premises. The Lessee shall make all structural 40 repairs, including, but not limited to, structural columns and floors, roofs, and exterior

- walls of the Premises, and maintain the parking facilities servicing the Premises. The
 Lessor agrees to cut and maintain the grass areas located on the grounds of the
 Premises.

- 13 5. A new Paragraph 26 shall be added to the Lease, as follows:
 - a. The Lessor and its employees, representatives, agents, and servants, including any builder or contractor employed by the Lessor, shall have the absolute unconditional right at any and all reasonable times, after not less than forty-eight (48) hours notice to the Lessee (except in the case of an emergency where no such notice is required), to enter the Premises for any of the following purposes: (a) to inspect the Premises; (b) in the case of a safety hazard or other emergency, to make such repairs and/or changes in the Premises as the Lessor may deem necessary, the cost of which the Lessee shall reimburse within thirty (30) calendar days of the Lessor's invoice; (c) to enforce and carry out any provision of this Lease; (d) for any purpose relating to the safety, protection or preservation of the Premises; or (e) for any other purpose related to the enforcement of this Lease.
 - b. The Lessor shall use reasonable efforts to minimize interference to the Lessee's business or use of the Premises when making inspections or when otherwise on the Premises, but the Lessor shall not be required to perform the inspections or otherwise enter the Premises at any time other than during normal working hours.
- Furthermore, it is understood and agreed by the parties that the Lessor's annual community grant contribution to the Lessee for the Lessor's fiscal year of 2016 shall be eliminated in and as consideration of the elimination of rent under the Lease.
- 32 7. Exhibit A, attached to this Amendment, shall be incorporated into the Lease.
- 33 8. All other terms and conditions of the Lease shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
- This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts and by the parties hereto in separate counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be deemed to be an original and all of which taken together shall constitute but one and the same instrument.
