O-2-16 Amending the Composition of the Maritime Advisory Board Staff Report

The legislation amends Title 2, Section 48.240 which defines the membership of the Maritime Advisory Board. The Board presently consists of:

- 1. Seven members representing the maritime industry, three of whom shall employ no more than twenty people. These members are appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council.
- 2. The chair of the Annapolis Conservancy Board or designee.
- 3. The Aldermen representing wards 1, 7, and 8 or their designees.

O-2-16 proposes to remove the chair of the Annapolis Conservancy Board from the membership of the Maritime Advisory Board and to replace that position with another appointee from the maritime industry. The change is a joint request of the Chairs of the Annapolis Conservancy Board and the Maritime Advisory Board.
