

TRANSPORTATION NETWORK SERVICES

O-11-16

Staff Report

This legislation imposes an assessment on Transportation Network Services for trips that originate in the City of Annapolis in accordance with the ANN. CODE OF MD., PUBLIC UTILITIES ARTICLE, Section 10-406.

SB 868 of the 2015 legislative session established a regulatory framework for “transportation network services” that encompasses “transportation network companies” and “transportation network operators.” Transportation network companies are considered common carriers. As a result of the adoption of that legislation, local governments are now authorized to assess transportation network services that originate in their jurisdiction up to 25 cents per trip, subject to specified requirements. The Senate bill took effect July 1, 2015.

O-11-16 further provides that the fee of .25 cents shall be set forth in the annual fees schedule and is subject to amendment.
