## Updating and Amending Title 12 of the Annapolis City Code (Chapters 12.04, 12.20, 12.24, 12.28 and 12.32)

For the purpose of updating and amending Chapters 12.04, 12.20, 12.24, 12.28 and 12.32 of the Annapolis City Code to permit an authorized agent of the City to exercise limited authority related to parking enforcement, residential parking permits, towing and other parking matters; to permit the use of modern technology related to parking meters, parking permits and other parking matters; and matters generally relating to Chapters 12.04, 12.20, 12.24, 12.28 and 12.32.

Pursuant to a Management Agreement dated February 23, 2016 between the City of Annapolis and Central Parking System of Maryland, Inc. (also known as SP+), the City hired SP+ to manage certain parking matters within the City limits, including, but not limited to, parking meters, garages, parking lots, residential permits, parking enforcement (including towing), installation of new equipment/technologies, and various studies related to parking matters.

The proposed changes to Chapters 12.04, 12.20, 12.24, 12.28 and 12.32 are needed to clearly provide SP+ with the authority to perform its obligations under the Management Agreement, and to permit SP+ to utilize more modern technologies than what the City Code currently allows for.
