14	D.	The term of a refillable container license issued to a successful applicant shall be
15		the same as the term of the license that the applicant holds at the time of
16		application.
17	E.	The hours of sale for a refillable container license shall begin at the same time as
18		the hours for the license already held by the license holder and shall end at
19		midnight.
20	F.	A license holder may refill only a refillable container that was branded by a
