32 33	<b>WHEREAS,</b> the majority of Special Residential Parking District (SRPD) 3 and all of SRPD 4 are in effect from eight a.m. to six p.m., Monday through Friday; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, the commercial success of the MX Zone between Church Circle and
36	Westgate Circle has increased the number of customers, clients, patrons, and employees
37	that visit the area with their automobiles; and
38	
39	WHEREAS, increased parking demand now saturates the residential areas adjacent to
40 41	the MX Zone in the evenings and on weekends; and
42	WHEREAS, three City parking garages and additional private garages are available and
43	open to the public along the MX Zone; and

45 46	WHEREAS, Section 12.32.030 of the Code of the City of Annapolis provides that residents may petition the Transportation Board to create, alter, or eliminate SRPDs; and

1 WHEREAS, residents of Murray Hill petitioned the Transportation Board to extend the 2 hours of SRPD 3 to midnight, seven days a week on certain streets within Murray Hill; 3 4 and 5 WHEREAS, residents of President's Hill petitioned the Transportation Board to extend 6 the hours of SRPD 4 to midnight, seven days a week on the streets within President's 7 Hill; and 8 9 10 **WHEREAS**, the Transportation Board received these petitions at their meeting on April 22, 2016, deliberated upon them, and voted to recommend the requested changes to the 11 City Council; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the Transportation Board notified the Council of its recommendation on 14 15 May 23, 2016; and 16 17 WHEREAS, Sections 12.32.050 and 12.32.060 of the Annapolis City Code require the City Council to prominently post notice within the area under consideration, hold an 18 19 advertised public hearing, and act upon the Transportation Board's recommendation by Ordinance within 60 days. 20 21 22 SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS 23 **CITY COUNCIL** that the Code of the City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as 24 25 follows: 26 **CHAPTER 12.32 – SPECIAL RESIDENTIAL PARKING DISTRICTS** 27 12.32.170 - Special residential parking district No. 3. 28 29 A.
