**Against the proposed harbor line change at the South Annapolis Yachting Center**

**TO: The Annapolis City Mayor, The Annapolis City Council and The Annapolis Port Wardens.**

We the undersigned have reviewed the proposed Harbor Line Change requested by The South Annapolis Yachting Center (SAYC). Petitioners are residents of Eastport, many of whom have boats in slips on Spa Creek and others have boat slips at their waterfront property.

We are concerned about the proposed harbor line change. It is not in our best interest or is in the interest of the safety of vessels and persons transiting the already too narrow channel between the SAYC Docks and the Old Arnie Gay Docks. We request that you postpone approving this change until the actual marina plans are submitted. We request you make sure that City Ordinance 15.18.80 is addressed when reviewing the SAYC marina plan documents. The docks need to be setback to not allow SAYC now or in the future to violate the Harbor Line and Ordinance 15.18.80. ("T" heads as explained below are setback off the harbor line to assure large beam vessels /length of vessels, will not intrude into or past the harbor line). We request you not approve a change in the harbor line until such plans meet all the requirements of 15.18.80.

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We are further concerned with some of the wording in 15.18.80: "Appropriate Distance". Some vessels have beams such -- 48 Aquila catamarans beam is 23+ft; 57 Lagoon catamaran beam is 29.98 ft; 43 ft. mooring catamaran beam is 22" ft. These dimensions need to be taken into consideration when approving the Marina plans.

We are hopeful you will help protect the safety of all those who use Spa Creek. Thank you
