B. NOTHING IN THIS CHAPTER SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT A CITY EMPLOYEE FROM:

1. PARTICIPATING IN TASK FORCE ACTIVITIES WITH FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITIES.

2. INVESTIGATING VIOLATIONS OF LAW, AS LONG AS SUCH INVESTIGATION IS NOT FOR THE PURPOSE OF FURTHERING AN INVESTIGATION BASED ON AN ALLEGED CIVIL VIOLATION OF FEDERAL IMMIGRATION LAW.

3. COOPERATING WITH FEDERAL IMMIGRATION AUTHORITIES WHO HAVE ESTABLISHED THAT PROBABLE CAUSE EXISTS TO APPREHEND AN UNDOCUMENTED FOREIGN-BORN RESIDENT WHO HAS ENGAGED IN CRIMINAL ACTIVITY.

4. PURSUING CITY SANCTIONED INITIATIVES OR PROGRAMS WHEN INQUIRY INTO AN INDIVIDUAL'S IMMIGRATION STATUS IS REQUIRED FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING ELIGIBILITY FOR SERVICES OR BENEFITS TO SUCH INDIVIDUALS AS LONG AS THE INFORMATION ABOUT SUCH INDIVIDUAL'S IMMIGRATION STATUS IS NOT USED FOR ANY PURPOSE RELATED TO IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES.

5. DISCRIMINATING BASED ON AN INDIVIDUAL'S RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, NATIONAL ORIGIN, IMMIGRATION STATUS, AND/OR ABILITY TO SPEAK ENGLISH IF, AND ONLY IF, IT IS REQUIRED FOR CITY EMPLOYMENT OR TO RECEIVE A PARTICULAR SERVICE OR BENEFIT.

C. INFORMATION ABOUT AN INDIVIDUAL'S IMMIGRATION STATUS SHALL NOT BE RETAINED OR STORED IN ANY PUBLIC RECORD OR DATABASE, UNLESS IN FURTHERANCE OF A CITY SANCTIONED INITIATIVE OR PROGRAM REQUIRED BY LAW, AND IN THAT CASE SHALL BE KEPT CONFIDENTIAL FROM ANYONE NOT REQUIRED BY LAW TO HAVE SUCH INFORMATION.

## 3.50.030 - PENALTY.

EMPLOYEES WHO HAVE BEEN DETERMINED TO BE IN VIOLATION OF THIS CHAPTER SHALL BE SANCTIONED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE PERSONNEL SYSTEM AND APPLICABLE LAW.
