- H. The owners or operators of vehicles used by public service companies as defined in Article 78, Section 2(O) SECTION 1-101(x) OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES
 ARTICLE of the Annotated Code of Maryland are not required to apply for or to obtain the permit provided for in this section in order to reserve parking spaces in accordance with this section.
