Budge Proposed Amendments 7/10/17

Amendment 1:

Page 2, Line 32 insert: "THE CITY SHALL LIMIT EMPLOYEE PARKING IN HILLMAN GARAGE 90 DAYS AFTER THE GARAGE OPERATOR REPORTS THE GARAGE HAS BEEN AT 95% OR GREATER OCCUPANCY FOR THREE WORK DAYS PER WEEK, ON AVERAGE, IN A CALENDAR QUARTER. EMPLOYEE PARKING AT HILLMAN GARAGE SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:"

<u>Rationale:</u> Trigger this section of the code only when parking at Hillman reaches a certain threshold. Allow 90 days to notify employees of the change.

Amendment 2:

P.2, line 33: Strike "TWENTY" and insert "SIXTY"

Rationale: The City's present zoning requirements require 59 parking spaces within 500 feet for the City offices at City Hall, 161 Duke of Gloucester, and 143 Gorman.

Amendment 3:

P.3, line 22: Strike "on July 1, 2017" and insert "from the date of its passage."

<u>Rationale:</u> July 1 is in the past and clearly impractical. While Amendment 1, if adopted, moves the operationally effective date of this section out to the future, the ordinance itself needs to become effective promptly in order for Amendment 1 to start working.
