A. The creation of a school utilization chart in accordance with paragraph D. of this section, shall occur on January 1 and July 1 of each year. The Director of Planning and Zoning shall prepare a school utilization chart for use on both of these dates each year.

B. Testing for adequate school capacities is prepared by the Director of Planning and Zoning and is based on the school utilization chart, as described in paragraph D. below.

C. Notwithstanding the definition of "proposed project" in Section 22.04.010, residential developments exceeding eleven dwelling units shall not be approved at locations where:

1. The enrollment at the elementary and middle schools that serve the site, plus from the development proposed by the application the number of elementary and middle schools students expected to attend based on the school pupil generation factors yield per unit contained in the Anne Arundel County Educational Facilities Master Plan, is currently or projected to be equal to or greater than one hundredninety five percent of the sState-rRated eCapacity within three years; andor

 2. The enrollment at the high school that serves the site, plus from the development proposed by the application the number of high school students expected to attend based on the school pupil generation factors yield per unit contained in the Anne Arundel County Educational Facilities Master Plan, is currently or projected to be equal to or greater than one hundred twentyninety five percent of the sState-rRated eCapacity within three years.

D. The school capacity used in the school utilization chart shall include the following and shall not vary in substance from the information included in the Anne Arundel County Educational Facilities Master Plan, unless the variation is confirmed in writing by the Superintendent of the School Board, or his designee, or approved by resolution of the City Council:

- 1. The existing capacity of the school based on the program requirements of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education; and
- 2. Enrollment as of September 30; and
- 3. Projected enrollment for the subsequent three years as provided by Anne Arundel County Schools; and
- 4. Any applicable future capacity if:

- a. A contract for construction of the school or an addition to the school necessary to achieve the future capacity has been awarded; and
- b. The Board of Education estimates that the construction will be completed in time to be used for the beginning of classes in the school year in which the future capacity is included in the school utilization chart; and
 - c. Does not include capacity based on temporary or relocatable structures.
