AN ORDINANCE concerning

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Police Advisory Board

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FOR the purpose of establishing the Police Advisory Board; authorizing the powers
23 and duties of the Board; and matters generally relating to the Police Advisory
24 Board.

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SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS
34 **CITY COUNCIL** that the Code of the City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as
35 follows:

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TITLE 2- ADMINISTRATION

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Chapter 2.48 – Boards, Commissions and Committees

Article XVI - Police Advisory Board

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Section 2.48.500 - Established.

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There is established a Police Advisory Board to advise the Police Chief on matters
44 pertaining to the Annapolis Police Department. These matters include, but are not limited
45 to, the direction of the agency, policies and procedures, and crime issues.

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1 **Section 2.48.510 - Composition.**

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3 The Police Advisory Board shall consist of ten, uncompensated members selected by the
4 Police Chief. The members shall be a diverse group of Annapolis residents. Each
5 member shall serve on the Board for three years.

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7 **Section 2.48.520 - Duties.**

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9 A. The Board shall act in an advisory capacity to the Police Chief and/or his designees.
10 The Board shall review, evaluate, and make recommendations to the Police Chief
11 and/or his designees concerning:

- 12
13 1. Policies and procedures of the Police Department;
14 2. Crime reduction strategies;
15 3. Cooperative programs between the Department and the community.

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17 B. Members of the Board shall be responsible for providing information to their
18 respective communities.

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20 C. The Board shall not review internal disciplinary matters.

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22 **Section 2.48.530 - Officers—Bylaws.**

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24 A. The Board shall elect a chair and vice-chair from among its membership, who shall
25 serve in their respective positions for a term of one year.

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27 B. The Board may adopt bylaws and rules and regulations as it deems necessary and
28 desirable for the regulation and conduct of its meetings and activities.

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30 **SECTION II: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY**
31 **THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this ordinance shall take effect from the date
32 of its passage.
