Legislation Title: Itinerant Merchant Sales in the Historic District - 2018

Description: For the purpose of authorizing hawker, peddler, and itinerant merchant sales in the Historic District in conjunction with certain special events during calendar year 2018.

Analysis of Fiscal Impact: This legislation allows for the sale of merchandise in the Historic District in conjunction with the following special events in the following geographic locations. All hawkers, peddlers, and itinerant merchants are subject to the applicable fees according to the FY 2018 and FY 2019 Fee Schedule, as follows:
