24 **FOR** the purpose of authorizing the filing of an application with the Maryland Transit
25 Administration of the Maryland Department of Transportation for a Sections
26 5303, 5304, 5307, 5309, 5310, 5311, 5316, and/or 5317 grants under the Federal
27 Transit Act for a total amount of \$2,498,148 (\$1,629,051 for fixed route transit
28 operations; \$220,728 for ADA complementary paratransit services; \$405,000
29 capital grant for transit vehicle maintenance; \$234,905 capital grant for the
30 purchase of three (3) small buses (replacement), \$5,801 capital assistance for
31 the purchase of furniture for driver’s room and \$2,663 capital assistance for a

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35 **WHEREAS,** the Maryland Transit Administration is the designated recipient in Maryland for
36 grants under the Federal Transit Act; and

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38 **WHEREAS,** the Administrator of the Maryland Transit Administration of the Maryland
39 Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants to counties and to
40 local governments for public transportation programs or projects; and

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42 **WHEREAS,** the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the
43 applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of the project costs in
44 the program; and

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1 **WHEREAS,** it is required by the United States Department of Transportation in accordance
2 with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 that, in
3 connection with the filing of an application for assistance under the Federal
4 Transit Act, the applicant give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of
5 the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the United States Department of
6 Transportation requirements thereunder; and
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8 **WHEREAS,** it is the goal of the applicant that minority business enterprise be utilized to the
9 fullest extent possible in connection with this project, and that definite
10 procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that minority
11 business shall have the maximum construction contracts, supplies, equipment
12 contracts, or consultant and other services.
