- 5 WHEREAS, the Weather It Together: Cultural Resources Hazard Mitigation Plan took a community-based approach to hazard mitigation planning to support a more 6 7 resilient and sustainable historic downtown for the near-term threats of tidal flooding and natural disasters and for the longer-term inevitability of sea level 8 rise; and 9
- WHEREAS, the Weather It Together: Cultural Resources Hazard Mitigation Plan envisions for 11 Annapolis an adaptation approach that underscores the community's desire to 12 protect the natural heritage of the Chesapeake Bay; prioritizes preservation of 13 14 historic properties with significant community value; partners with public agencies and private stakeholders to reduce the costs and impacts associated with 15 flood protection and flooding hazards; and promotes both short- and long-term 16 strategies for flood protection; and 17
- WHEREAS the Weather It Together: Cultural Resources Hazard Mitigation Plan is an 19 20 overarching vision to guide the next five years of adaptation strategies or goals with measurable objectives implemented through projects with specific actions. 21
