Weather It Together: Cultural Resources Hazard Mitigation Plan

Staff Report

The Weather It Together: Cultural Resources Hazard Mitigation Plan (CRHMP) is an addendum to the City's Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan. It focuses on our cultural and historical resources that are most at risk and particularly vulnerable to flooding and the impacts of sea level rise. This plan took a community-based approach to hazard mitigation planning to support a more resilient and sustainable historic downtown for both the near and long-term.

The plan envisions for Annapolis an adaptation approach that underscores the community's desire to protect the natural heritage of the Chesapeake Bay; prioritizes preservation of historic properties with significant community value; and partners with public agencies and private stakeholders to reduce the costs and impacts associated with flood protection and flooding hazards.
