WHEREAS,		the City Council has adopted an official seal, flag, and logo, which are used in the authentication of the official documents and in the conduct of official City business; and
WHEREAS,		the authorized use of the City seal, City flag, or City logo informs the public that the City's reputation for integrity and service to the public is behind an event or organization acting in partnership with the City; and
WHEREAS,		the unauthorized use of the City seal, City flag, or City logo may mislead the public into believing that the City of Annapolis is supporting certain activities, individuals or entities: and
WHE	REAS,	appropriate regulations are necessary in order to insure that the City seal, City flag,
		and City logo are not utilized except in conjunction with official City business.

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TITLE 1 – GENERAL PROVISIONS

Chapter 1.08 – CITY EMBLEMS

Section 1.08.060 - Prohibited Uses.

For the purposes of this Section only, "City Emblem" is defined as the city seal, and city logo.

- A. The City emblem shall not be used for any political purpose, including but not limited to, campaign literature, mailers or handouts in a manner that would lead a reasonable person to mistakenly believe that the City of Annapolis, the city council, or any department, official, or employee of the city endorses, supports, approves, or sponsors; the stated political purpose.
- B. A violation of section 1.08.060A is a municipal infraction and the individual or entity shall be subject to a fine as established by resolution of the city council.

SECTION II: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that this Ordinance shall take effect from the date of its passage.
