Legislation Title: Arts and Entertainment District – Tax Credit

Description: For the purpose of providing certain tax credit incentives to eligible persons; and specifying the annual distribution of a real property tax credit incentive.

Analysis of Fiscal Impact: This legislation provides a credit against property taxes imposed on the assessment increase due to the construction or renovation of an eligible building in the City's State-designated Annapolis Arts and Entertainment District. The City may enact legislation to provide this credit pursuant to Section 9-240 of the Tax-Property Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

The proposed credit is a percentage of the property tax imposed on the increase in the assessment as a result of the construction or renovation of an eligible building as follows:

- 100% in each of the first three taxable years after the calendar year when the property is initially entitled to the credit;
- 75% in the 4th and 5th taxable years;
- 50% in the 6th and 7th taxable years;
- 25% in the 8th and 9th taxable years; and
- 10% in the 10th taxable year.

No credit is given after the 10th taxable year.

This fiscal impact of these property tax credits cannot be estimated because it depends on future construction and related increases in assessments, which cannot be predicted.
