Dr. Michael Metzger's calling throughout life has been to influence the influentials in order to promote human flourishing. He has done this as a coach,

In his book *Faith in the Halls of Power*, author Michael Lindsey named Clapham Institute and Metzger one of the nation's more influential leaders in innovation.
