In the event that the mayor is temporarily disabled or 34 absent from the City and fails to designate an acting mayor as above provided, the City 35 Manager shall serve as acting mayor until such time as If the mayor is disabled or absent 36 from the city and has failed to designate an acting mayor, the city council, at the call of 37 any member, may meets and, by a majority vote, designates an alderman to serve as 38 39 acting mayor. An acting mayor has the same rights, duties, powers and obligations as the mayor. 40 41 SECTION II: AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY 42 43 **COUNCIL** that a notice of public hearing was published on the proposed charter amendment, at least 21 days in advance of the public hearing that was held on 44 45

14	CITY COUNCIL that the Mayor is hereby specifically commanded to carry out the
15	provisions of Section II hereof, and, as evidence of such compliance, the Mayor shall
16	cause to be maintained appropriate certificates of publication of the newspaper or
17	newspapers in which the title of the Resolution shall have been published and if a
18	favorable referendum is held on the Charter change, shall declare the Charter change
19	hereby enacted to be effective on, 20, by affixing his signature hereto in the
20	space provided on the effective date of change.

27	cast for or against the amendment hereby enacted at any referendum thereon and the date
