Work experience (titles and duties)

After graduating college in 1995, I went to work in software engineering and design, implementing large-scale client-server computer applications for consulting companies in Pennsylvania and then in Maryland. In 2003, following the birth of my first child, I pursued freelance work, designing and implementing websites for small businesses.

At this time, I also resumed part-time tutoring in mathematics, for students in elementary through high school mathematics courses. I have been a mathematics tutor since 1988, and I feel strongly that mathematics should be accessible and enjoyable for all students.

When my first child entered school in 2007, I began volunteering in AACPS schools, in whatever capacity was needed. In 2014, the librarian at Annapolis Middle School trained me to process books for circulation, and I volunteered in that capacity one day a week at AMS over the next three years, adding a day first at Georgetown East Elementary and later at Monarch Academy Annapolis as my youngest entered AACPS schools.

I am currently employed by WoolWinders, where I both design curriculum and teach classes for various knitting projects and techniques as well as designing knitting patterns.

Educational background (certificates, diplomas, degrees, seminars, etc)

I hold a Bachelor of Science in Mathematical Science from Penn State University, with concentrations in Operations Research (Mathematical Logistics) and Computer Science. I have also completed post-graduate coursework in Computer Science.

I have been a member of various PTA organizations in five different schools in the Annapolis Cluster over the past twelve years (Hillsmere Elementary School, Georgetown East Elementary School, Monarch Academy Annapolis, Annapolis Middle School, and Annapolis High School), in which I have served in various positions, both on the board of directors and as a committee chair.
