#### Purpose ·

The purpose of Ordinance O-2-19 is to amend several sections of the sign regulations in reference to freestanding signs, wall-mounted signs, and business community identification signs. A portion of this ordinance was previously heard by the Planning Commission as part of Ordinance O-19-18, which did not pass City Council in full.

#### **Analysis**

This ordinance makes two changes to Section 21.70.080 Sign Table 1, Types of Signs Permitted in Non-Residential Zoning Districts. These two changes would allow a Business Community Identification Sign in these zoning districts: B2, B3, B3-CD, BCE, and I1 and allow Freestanding Signs in these zoning districts: P and PM. A "Business Community Identification Sign" is a sign "representing an area consisting of no less than six distinct businesses located on separate parcels of land." A "Freestanding Sign" is "any sign supported by structures or supports that are placed on, or anchored in, the ground and that are independent from any building or other structure" (Section 21.72.010).

This ordinance additionally makes several amendments to Sign Table 2, Regulations for Signs in Non-Residential Zoning Districts. First, it increases the height of wall-mounted signs in the B1, BR, PM, and MX zoning districts from 13 feet to 15 feet. The intent is to allow property owners to be able to mount a sign that is at or below the height of a second-story window.

In wall-mounted signs in the WME, WMI, and WMM zoning district, this ordinance adds previously missing language to the columns under, "Number of Signs Allowed," "Maximum Height (feet)," "Illumination Permitted," and "Projection Permitted."

For freestanding signs, this ordinance removes the requirement that only lots with a minimum width of 100 feet or larger may have a freestanding sign. When the Planning Commission heard Ordinance O-19-18 last year, it recommended that if a freestanding sign were to be allowed on a lot less than 100 feet or larger in width, the sign would have to be a ground sign. A "Ground sign" means "a sign where the entire bottom of the sign is in contact with or in close proximity to the ground. A 'monument sign' is a ground sign (Section 21.72.010).

The changes described above provide consistency between zoning classifications and the type of signs permitted.

### Recommendation

Based upon the information provided above, staff recommends that the proposed O-2-19 be APPROVED.

In using the table the following regulations apply:

- a. Lots are permitted both wall-mounted and freestanding signs up to the limits set forth in the table. With the exception of the signage allowed in Table Note 1, signage in multi-tenant facilities is counted as an alternative, not in addition, to permitted wall-mounted and freestanding signs.
- b. For wall-mounted signs the maximum sign area is for the lot, with the exception of the signage allowed in Table Note 1.
- c. For all other signs the maximum sign area is the maximum area per sign face, unless stated otherwise. For example, a two-sided, freestanding, ground sign in the BCE could be thirty square feet per face or sixty square feet total.
- d. The following abbreviations are used in the table: sf = square feet; lf = linear feet; bldg = building; " = inches.
- e. Important. The notes at the end of the table are as much a part of the law as the table itself.

- 1 For sign(s) located within six hundred feet of Solomons Island Road/MD Route 2 and upon property at least five acres in area and zoned within the B2 District, the regulations shall be as follows:
- a. Wall-mounted. Maximum sign area: (i) six sf per lf of building frontage up to a maximum of one thousand six hundred sf, (ii) No single sign may exceed three hundred forty sf in area; Number of signs allowed: No limit up to permitted sign area; Maximum Height (feet): thirty-two; Maximum sign board

height: eleven and one-half feet; Maximum lettering height: six feet; Illumination permitted: Yes; Projection permitted: Yes, up to one and one-half feet into a public way.

- b. Freestanding (lots with one or more businesses). Maximum sign area: (i) pole signs: twenty-four sf, (ii) ground signs: thirty sf; Number of signs allowed: one per street frontage; Maximum Height (feet): (i) pole signs: fifteen, ground signs: twelve; Minimum setback from property lines: ten feet; Minimum lot width: one hundred feet; Illumination permitted: Yes; Projection permitted: Yes, but not into a public way.
- c. Multi-tenant facility identification sign. Maximum sign area: three hundred forty sf per side; Number of signs allowed: one per street frontage; Maximum Height (feet): thirty-five; Minimum setback from property lines: fifteen feet; Illumination permitted: Yes; Projection permitted: Yes, but not into a public way.
- d. Anchor tenant, wall-mounted. Allowed in accordance with the regulations for wall-mounted signs in preceding subsection a.

Title: Freestanding Signs

#### STAFF REPORT

This ordinance amends Section 21.70.080 of the City Code pertaining to freestanding signs, wall-mounted signs, and business community identification signs.

- Section 21.70.080 Types of Signs Permitted in Non-Residential Sign Table 1: This
  amendment would allow freestanding signs in the P and PM zoning district. Currently
  many properties in the P and PM zoning districts have freestanding signs. This
  amendment would permit the signs and reduce the amount of nonconformity.
- Section 21.70.080 Regulations for Signs in Non-Residential Zoning Districts Sign Table
   2: This amendment changes the height of wall-mounted signs allowed in the B1, BR,
   PM, and MX zoning district from 13 feet to 15 feet, which would placement of a sign to be slightly above the first floor of a building.
- Section 21.70.080 Regulations for Signs in Non-Residential Zoning Districts Sign Table
   2: This amendment adds text related to the number of signs, maximum height, illumination permitted, and projection permitted that was inadvertently deleted from the sign table for wall-mounted signs in zoning districts WME, WMI, and WMM.
- Section 21.70.080 In Regulations for Signs in Non-Residential Zoning Districts Sign Table 2: Currently freestanding signs may be placed only where there is a minimum lot width of 100. This amendment would remove this restriction and allow freestanding signs on smaller lots. This applies to freestanding signs in the B1, WMC, B2, B3, B3-CD, BCE, I1, P, PM, WME, WMI, and WMM zoning districts.

Additionally, this ordinance would allow a "business community identification sign" in the B2, B3, B3-CD, BCE, and I1 zoning districts, in addition to the B1, P, and PM zoning districts where such signs are already permitted. The standards for a business community identification sign are:

Maximum Sign Area: 30 sf

• Number of Signs Allowed: 1 at each entry point

Maximum Height:

6 feet

• Illumination Permitted:

Yes, by external means only, such as spotlight

• Projection Permitted:

Yes, but not into a public way

• Other:

This type of sign is for communities comprising six or

more businesses.
