  - Prepare forecasts and statistics of economic conditions in the City.
  - 10. Analyze the economic impact of proposed legislation.
  - 1011. Participate in the urban and regional planning activities of the City, Anne Arundel County, and the Regional Planning Organizations consistent with the character of the City.

  - 1213. Provide technical assistance and information to the business community and its recognized associations.
