## SECTION 25: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE

ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that a City property tax rate for the taxable year beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020, is hereby levied and imposed on all assessments, persons, or property subject to ordinary taxation in the City of Annapolis, and that the rate of taxation for such taxable year is hereby fixed at \$0.0738 on each \$100 of full assessed value of real property, and \$1.94 on each \$100 of the full assessed value of personal property located within the corporate limits of the City of Annapolis.

## SECTION 26: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE

**ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that it shall be the duty of the Director of Finance of the City of Annapolis to collect the sums set apart for the several funds, to keep separate receipts and amounts thereof, to deposit the same to the credit of funds as required by the several Acts and Ordinances relating to and providing for the several bonds issued, and to receive on account thereof only current money and legal tender of the United States.

#### SECTION 27: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE

**ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that taxes levied by this Ordinance remaining unpaid on October 1, 2020, except for taxpayers who elect to make a partial payment before October 1 with the balance due later as allowed by State law, shall be overdue, and from and after that date shall bear interest, to be collected with said taxes, at the rate of one and one-half percent (1.5%) per month until paid.

# SECTION 28: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE

ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that the annual operating budget for Fiscal Year 2020 is hereby approved and finally adopted for such fiscal year; and funds for all expenditures for the purposes specified in the budget for Fiscal Year 2020 are hereby appropriated in the amounts therein specified and will be used by the City in the sums itemized in said budget hereby adopted for the principal objectives and purposes thereof, and the total sum of funds herein provided for the respective departments and major operating units thereof, boards, commissions and agencies.
