Management in the exempt service; establishing certain exempt service pay grades; and reassigning responsibility for floodplain management to the Department of Planning and Zoning.

O-13-19 Office of Law - For the purpose of clarifying the functions of the Office of Law; clarifying the functions of the City Clerk; making technical corrections; and making stylistic changes.

O-14-19 Economic Development Division - For the purpose of relocating the Economic Development Division from the Department of Planning and Zoning to the Office of the Mayor; and generally related to Economic Development.

O-16-19 Human Resources - Exempt Service - For the purpose of reclassifying certain positions in the Exempt Service; and making stylistic changes.
