Subject: O-30-19 - Sidewalk Signs

This ordinance authorizes the Director of Planning and Zoning to revoke or suspend a sign permit approval in certain circumstances and delays the effective date of the sidewalk sign permit fee to November 11, 2019.

O-42-18, the predecessor to O-30-19, was referred to the Planning Commission, and on July 7, 2019, the Planning Commission issued its Findings and Recommendations. Subsequently, during standing committee review of O-42-18, the Economic Matters Committee and the Rules and City Government Committee approved O-42-18 as amended by the Planning Commission recommendations numbered 2, 3, and 4. However, on May 13, 2019, the City Council adopted O-42-18 without those amendments.

O-30-19 captures the Planning Commission recommended amendments 2, 3, and 4 that were previously approved by the Economic Matters Committee and Rules and City Government Committee.
