Subject: O-36-19: Parking Meters

This ordinance amends Section 12.24.030 of the City Code pertaining to parking meters.

Currently the City Code provisions contemplate only the use of single space meters that are located physically adjacent to a single parking space. The Code requires that “Each meter shall be placed, set, or designated to show or display by signal, receipt, or other electronic means that the parking space adjacent to a parking meter is or is not legally in use.” (Emphasis added.)

The proposed amendment accommodates the use of multispace kiosks and mobile device applications to reserve spaces. It amends the Code to provide that each parking meter shall be placed to show or display by signal, receipt, or other electronic means that the parking space “reserved by a parking meter, KIOSK, OR MOBILE DEVICE” is or is not legally in use.
