18 **FOR** the purpose of increasing the distance for sending written notification to abutting property
19 owners for Planned Developments, Major Subdivisions, and Major Site Design
20 applications.

21 **BY** repealing and re-enacting with amendments the following portions of the Code of the City
22 of Annapolis, 2020 Edition
23 21.10.020

24 **SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY**
25 **COUNCIL** that the Code of the City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as follows:

26 **Title 21 – PLANNING AND ZONING**
27 **Chapter 21.10 – GENERAL APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND FEES**

28 **Section 21.10.020 - Notice requirements.**

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- 42 A. Posting of property. If the Zoning Code Division II provisions applicable to a specific type
43 of application provide for posting of property, unless specific notice procedures are
44 otherwise provided for in another Zoning Code chapter or section, posting must be done
45 follows:
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- 1 1. Notice must be posted on the property that is the subject of an application at least fifteen
2 days prior to a decision on the application and in a manner prescribed by the Planning
3 and Zoning Director.
- 4 2. In the case of an application for demolition of buildings and structures pursuant to Section
5 21.40.060(C)(3), in the R2-NC district, notice must be posted on the property that is the
6 subject of an application at least thirty days prior to a decision on the application and in
7 a manner prescribed by the Planning and Zoning Director.
- 8 3. It is the responsibility of an applicant to post any notice required under Subsections (A)(1)
9 or (A)(2) on the property that is the subject of an application, unless the applicant is not
10 the property owner, in which case it is the responsibility of the property owner.
- 11 4. In the case of appeals to any Board of Appeals, failure of the property owner responsible
12 pursuant to Subsection (A)(3), to post any notice required under Subsections (A)(1) or
13 (A)(2) shall result in a stay of all proceedings, including those in furtherance of the action
14 or decision appealed. The failure of a property owner, who is not the applicant, to post
15 any notice required under Subsections (A)(1) or (A)(2) shall not be a basis for the
16 dismissal of any appeal to any Board of Appeals. In such circumstances, any issued
17 permits, including but not limited to building, use and occupancy, and other permits, shall
18 be suspended and/or revoked until such time as the property owner posts the notice.
19 Should injunctive proceedings become necessary to require the posting, all costs shall be
20 borne by the property owner and assessed as a lien against the property.
- 21 5. Any sign posted on a property by an applicant must be removed by the applicant within
22 seven days following the decision.
- 23
24 B. Notice to Abutting Property Owners. If the Zoning Code Division II provisions applicable
25 to a specific type of application provide for notice to abutting property owners, unless
26 specific notice procedures are otherwise provided for in another Zoning Code chapter,
27 notice must be given as follows:
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29 1. The applicant shall send written notification to:
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31 a. All parties with a financial or vested interest in the property that is the subject of the
32 application,
33 b. Property owners and tenants of property located within ~~two hundred~~ 200 feet of any
34 property boundary of the proposed development, EXCEPT THAT THIS WRITTEN
35 NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENT SHALL BE 750 FEET FOR PLANNED
36 DEVELOPMENTS, SUBDIVISIONS THAT DO NOT MEET THE CRITERIA
37 FOR AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 20.08.030, AND MAJOR SITE
38 DESIGN PLAN APPLICATIONS,
39 c. The Alderperson representing the ward for which the project is planned,
40 d. The President or other person in a position of authority of any Community
41 Association, including but not limited to, homeowners associations, condominium
42 associations, resident associations, and business associations whose geographic
43 boundaries lie within 200 feet of the proposed development, EXCEPT THAT THIS
44 WRITTEN NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENT SHALL BE 750 FEET FOR
45 PLANNED DEVELOPMENTS, SUBDIVISIONS THAT DO NOT MEET THE
46 CRITERIA FOR AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 20.08.030, AND MAJOR

1 SITE DESIGN PLAN APPLICATIONS. The list of associations and their contact
2 information, including the name of the association's president or other person in a
3 position of authority, the association's mailing address, and the association's email
4 address shall be maintained by the Office of the Mayor, and,

- 5 e. In the case of a required community meeting, cause to be published, in a newspaper
6 of general circulation in the city at least fifteen days before the community meeting,
7 notification of such meeting.
8

9 2. Notice of public hearings must be mailed not less than fifteen days prior to the date of
10 hearing.

11 3. Prior to any public meeting or public hearing on an application, the applicant must
12 provide the Planning and Zoning Director with verification of mailing of written
13 notification. An applicant must provide evidence that notices of the public hearing were
14 mailed not less than fifteen days prior to the date of hearing.
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16 C. Notice of Formal Public Hearing. If notice of a formal public hearing is required, unless
17 specific notice procedures are otherwise provided for in another Division II chapter of the
18 Zoning Code, notice must be given as follows:
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20 1. Notice of the application and any required public hearings at which the application will
21 be considered shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City at least
22 fifteen days before the hearing.

23 2. Notice must be posted on the property that is the subject of an application by the applicant
24 or the property owner, if not the same, at least fifteen days prior to any public hearing on
25 the application and in a manner prescribed by the Planning and Zoning Director. Any
26 sign posted on a property by an applicant must be removed by the applicant within seven
27 days following the close of the public hearing. Failure to post shall be governed by
28 Subsection (A)(4) above.
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30 D. Notice of Public Meeting. If notice of a public meeting at which an application may be
31 considered is required, unless specific notice procedures are otherwise provided for in another
32 Division II chapter of the Zoning Code, notice must be given as follows:
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34 1. Notice of the application and any public meeting at which the application will be
35 considered shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City no fewer
36 than fifteen days before the meeting.

- 37 i. Notice must be posted on the property that is the subject of an application at least
38 fifteen days prior to any public meeting on the application and in a manner prescribed
39 by the Planning and Zoning Director. Any sign posted on a property by an applicant
40 must be removed by the applicant within seven days following the public meeting.
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42 E. Notice of Decision. Notice of any decision on the application by the Planning and Zoning
43 Director or the decision making body, must be given to the applicant, the Mayor and City
44 Council, and any other persons who made written comments or testified at a hearing
45 concerning the application, provided they included their legal name and valid mailing address

1 or valid email address. Such notice of decision shall be by mail or email and provided by the
 2 Planning and Zoning Director not more than five days following the date of final decision.

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 4 F. Summary of Public Meeting and Hearing Requirements. The table below summarizes the
 5 types of applications requiring a public meeting or public hearing and the City official or
 6 decision making body responsible for conducting the meeting or hearing. If more than one
 7 application or approval is required for a proposed development or activity, public hearings on
 8 each application may be simultaneously held by a decision making body on related
 9 applications.
