Subject: R-20-20: Swimming Pool Fees

Resolution 16-19 set the fees for City services in FY2020. This resolution (R-20-20) amends the FY2020 fee schedule with fees for the new City of Annapolis swimming pool effective April 1, 2020. The new swimming pool is expected to open in late May 2020.

The fees are revised as follows:

Adult Single Use

City Resident	Increase from \$5 to \$6 per day
Non-Resident	Increase from \$5 to \$10 per day

Child (12 and under) and Senior (62+) Single Use

City Resident	Increase from \$4 to \$5 per day
Non-Resident	Increase from \$4 to \$7 per day

Season Pass – Family

City Resident	Increase from \$160 to \$200 for family of four, increase from \$15 to \$20 for each additional child
Non-Resident	Increase from \$185 to \$240 for family of four, increase from \$15 to \$20 for each additional child

Season Pass – Youth Individual

City Resident	Increase from \$55 to \$130
Non-Resident	Increase from \$65 to \$155

Season Pass – Adult

City Resident	Increase from \$65 to \$190
Non-Resident	Increase from \$75 to \$225

Pool Party
City Resident Remove “or fraction thereof” after “two hours”
Non-Resident Add “\$300/two hours”
