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36 **WHEREAS,** the Maryland Transit Administration is the designated recipient in Maryland for
37 grants under the Federal Transit Act; and

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39 **WHEREAS,** the Administrator of the Maryland Transit Administration of the Maryland
40 Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants to counties and to local
41 governments for public transportation programs or projects; and

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43 **WHEREAS,** the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the
44 applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of the project costs in
45 the program; and

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1 **WHEREAS,** it is required by the United States Department of Transportation in accordance
2 with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 that, in connection
3 with the filing of an application for assistance under the Federal Transit Act, the
4 applicant give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights
5 Act of 1964 and the United States Department of Transportation requirements
6 thereunder; and
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8 **WHEREAS,** it is the goal of the applicant that minority business enterprise be utilized to the
9 fullest extent possible in connection with this project, and that definite procedures
10 shall be established and administered to ensure that minority business shall have
11 the maximum construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts, or consultant
12 and other services.
