17 **FOR** the purpose of extending the termination date of the Declaration of State of Emergency for
18 the City of Annapolis issued on March 12, 2020.

21 **WHEREAS,** on March 12, 2020, in accordance with Section 11.48.030.A of the Annapolis City
22 Code, the Mayor issued a Declaration of State of Emergency due to the ongoing
23 federal and state warnings regarding illness and deaths resulting from exposure to
24 the COVID-19 virus existing on March 5, 2020, within the United States of
25 America; and

27 **WHEREAS,** the Mayor's Declaration of State of Emergency was for a period of 30 days and
28 terminated on April 11, 2020; and

29
30 **WHEREAS,** on April 6, 2020, the City Council adopted R-24-20, which extended the Mayor's
31 Declaration of State of Emergency for an additional period of 30 days to terminate
32 on May 11, 2020; and

34 **WHEREAS,** to protect the public health, welfare, and safety, prevent the transmission of
35 COVID-19, control the spread of COVID-19, and save lives, the Mayor finds it
36 necessary to extend the current State of Emergency; and

38 **WHEREAS,** the City Council, pursuant to Section 11.48.030.B consents to extending the State
39 of Emergency for an additional 30 days through June 10, 2020.

41 **NOW, THEREFORE,**

43 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the March 12, 2020,
44 Declaration of State of Emergency issued by the Mayor of Annapolis shall be extended through
45 June 10, 2020.
