

STAFF REPORT ON PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Under Current City Code, a person is <u>not</u> allowed to ride on or use "in a negligent manner" any nonmotorized wheeled vehicle on a public street, alley, or sidewalk. This implies that a person <u>can</u> therefore ride on or use a non-motorized wheeled vehicle on a public street, alley, or sidewalk if done in a careful manner. The purpose of this ordinance is to simplify the language to make it clear and to explicitly identify the kinds of non-motorized wheeled vehicles that are included.

Furthermore, this ordinance exempts certain sidewalks or sidewalk areas where there is a sign posted that prohibits non-motorized wheeled vehicles.
