

Legislation Deadlines for Municipal Election Year 2021.

Section 2.16.090 paragraph A of the Annapolis City Code provides that “all three readings of an ordinance, and charter amendment shall occur during the same term of the Council” and paragraph C of that section also provides that “both readings of a resolution shall occur during the same term of the Council.”

The last scheduled meeting of the City Council for this term is Monday, October 25, 2021. Pursuant to the Annapolis Charter, Article IV, Section 4(a), the City Council will not meet in August and during the month of November in the year of a municipal general election.

In view of the foregoing Charter and Code provisions, and to accommodate the Public Hearing process and any referrals, the deadlines for the timely introduction and passage of legislation in 2021 are as follows:

Deadline for Introduction on First Reader:

Charter Amendments – June 14, 2021

Ordinances – June 14, 2021

Resolutions – July 12, 2021
