20 21 22	WHEREAS,	Columbus Day is observed as a federal holiday on the second Monday in October; and
23 24 25 26	WHEREAS,	the day recognizes the October 12, 1492 landing of Christopher Columbus on an island in the Caribbean, marking the Europeans' first contact with the "New World;" and
27 28 29 30	WHEREAS,	this contact began centuries of settlement on lands already occupied by native peoples of the Americas and exploitation of the New World's seemingly endless resources; and
31 32 33	WHEREAS,	indigenous Americans experienced conquest, enslavement, displacement, and disease which decimated the population; and
34 35 36 37	WHEREAS,	native people who were removed from this area likely include the Piscataway, the Anacostank, Pamunkey, Mattapanient, Nangemeick [nan-ga-mik], and Tauxehent; and
38 39 40 41 42	WHEREAS,	a growing number of states, counties, cities, and towns across the United States recognize the second Monday of October as Indigenous Peoples Day, re-imagining Columbus Day as an opportunity to celebrate indigenous heritage and resiliency; and
13 14 15 16	WHEREAS,	although it is a federal holiday, Columbus Day is not a holiday for City of Annapolis employees and City government functions and meetings continue on their usual schedule; and

2	WHEREAS, recognizing the second Monday in October as Indigenous Peoples Day will serve		
3	as a reminder to reflect on the native people who were here before us, and their		
4	descendants.
