Ordinance: O-42-20

Title: Emergency Medical Services

Date: October 23, 2020

This Ordinance will allow the City to charge a fee for medical services if a citizen is treated but not transported to a medical facility. This should increase the amount of revenue the Fire department collects for these services. Fire department staff estimate there are approximately 100 such instances each year. Therefore, using current minimum treatment rates, we estimate this ordinance would increase revenue by at least \$35,000.
