Work experience (titles and duties)

Senior Project Manager, The Trust for Public Land - November 1998 until present

The Trust for Public Land (TPL) is a national, non-profit land conservation and park organization with headquarters in San Francisco. Working from more than 30 offices nationwide, TPL helps communities raise funds, conduct research and planning, acquire and protect land, and design and renovate parks, playgrounds, trails, and gardens. Community is at the center of our work and our current strategic plan places a special emphasis on equity, health and climate. TPL helps lead the national 10-minute walk to a park Mayoral campaign.

I work remotely from home in Annapolis and am affiliated with the work of our Chesapeake Bay Field Office co-located in Washington, DC along with our Federal Affairs and Climate teams. I carry out our land protection / park acquisition activities in the region, focused principally on projects in Virginia, but have worked throughout the bay states. Over twenty years with TPL, I have negotiated the acquisition of land and conservation easements valued at over \$100 million dollars, resulting in over 20,000 acres of land conserved. This has included the creation of many local and state parks, as well as additions to federal land holdings involving the National Park Service, the US Forest Service and the US Fish and Wildlife Service. My current land projects involve many conservation easements utilizing public funding, including through the Dept. of Defense's REPI program to prevent incompatible development.

I have twenty years of experience working with a variety of private and corporate landowners to facilitate conservation of their land which includes tapping available public and philanthropic funding, as well as securing donations of land and easement value and explaining the federal and state benefits available to landowners.

I have served on the board of a statewide land trust and currently serve on the state association of land trusts in Virginia where best easement practices are developed and shared.
